Field Space. The preliminary fall practice field assignments from the July 23 club meeting were handed out by Bill Johnson. Because JLS fields will be closed in September (due to unfinished repairs) and some team desired to switch practice days or fields many changes were discussed and confirmed. These assignments will be emailed to teams and posted on the club website. Unused fields may be identified in the second week of September when the city reviews AYSO/CYSA feedback of actual usage. In addition Greer 3 and Greer 4 are under maintenance although still in use. Hopefully teams originally assigned practice fields at JLS can return there in October.

In a related issue Fausto pointed out that he was unable to attend the July meeting due to unusual circumstances and that he was not assigned to his desired Greer fields. This was another consideration in the field changes, but indicated for the future an important need to get desired assignments forwarded to someone that can attend meeting.

There was uncertainty about U10 field availability at Ohlone. This needs to be coordinated with AYSO. Also (U10?) teams practicing at Ramos Park need to clarify half field practice areas.

Schedules: All schedules are now posted on the Redwood and Abronzino websites. Hill needs all field requests (for all fall games) submitted in the next week. Include *only* requested day and any constraints (and nothing else).

Field Lining: The Stanford Soccer Club is responsible to line the Greer fields each weekend for the fall. Chris Stirrat is taking the lead on this but may require help on a weekly basis. Teams should be prepared to provide a volunteer. A list may be provided to specify when each team needs to provide a volunteer.

Coach Required Licenses: Beginning in the 2002/2003 season coaches are required to pass F License certification or higher. It was suggested this could be accomplished with a two weekend class preferably held in Palo Alto. Note that a Head Coach will ultimately need E/D License certification. Information is posted on the Redwood League website.

Mandatory Redwood/ Abrozino Meetings: Mandatory coach (or manager?) meetings are scheduled for Abrozino on September 4 and Redwood League on September 13. Check website for time and location.
