Treasurer: Mike Naar distributed the club assets/expenses balance sheet. Paying club positions are Field/Referee Scheduler (\$250/season), Linesmen Scheduler (\$250/season), Registrar (\$250/year). The Registrar was proposed and accepted as a new paying position at this meeting. Some money in the club treasury was donated by past teams who upon disbanding, donated their remaining funds to the club (thank-you very much!). The spring team fee is \$125/team payable to "Stanford Soccer Club" and needs to be paid before a team will be assigned game fields.

Fields/Scheduling: Bill Johnson distributed a list of the club teams based on seniority. The club coordinators for game Field/Referee and Linesmen assignments (two different positions) will be assigned to the most senior team that has not yet served.

Spring practice fields were assigned to teams, most senior teams selecting first. Bill Johnson explained that the club's allocation of fields comes from the city, which divides fields between clubs, schools and adult league requests. A required representative from each team must be present to select a field or have instructions for selection available at meeting. Results will be emailed from Bill and posted on club website.

Chris Stirrat expects to start lining game fields during the 3rd week in February.

Coaching Certification: Juan will plan certification class for the CYSA 'F' license (required for coaches for fall 2002).

Other: Only Mike DeFrenza (club registrar) should communicate via email or phone to the Redwood League registrar.

Next Meeting: Next scheduled meeting is February 25, 2002, Cubberley Room A3.
