Teams: An updated Club Team List was distributed by Bill Johnson.

Coaching: Guest Coach Chris Sullivan (christopher@purofutbol.com) presented his qualifications as a trainer and handed out contact information. Chris has trained Tom O'Conner's teams.

Juan Mayora has a 'B' Coaching License which allows him to lead an 'F' Coach Certification Class after he receives his 'certifier' license. He hopes to offer the 'F' Coach Certification Class (required for fall 2002) next month.

Juan is also pursuing a plan for Goalkeeping training.

Treasurer: \$125 spring club dues (for teams using practice and game fields) should be made out to 'Stanford Soccer Club' and submitted to Mike Naar, 4080 El Cerito Rd, PA, 94306. Mike noted that the distributed treasurer report does not include some spring fee payments. Mike also distributed rules and information on making charitable contributions to the club and teams.

Fields/Scheduling/Referees: Palo Alto has constrained club usage to at JLS to JLS3 and half of JLS4 fields. Teams assigned to JLS need to work together to manage the space.

Bill Johnson distributed field permits for the assigned practice fields.

Teams must honor 'field closed' rule (e.g. rainout). Violation remedies discussed included expulsion from club, decreased club seniority. Club directors plan to bring recommendation to next club meeting.

Game field assignment requests should be emailed to Charlie Williams/Avalanche by this Saturday (midnight). We have limited Sunday fields (as Greer 5 closes May 1). Guidelines for requesting a game field were distributed (and available on club website). An attempt will be made to match veteran referees with 'new' linesmen. [note: Nancy Starr/Avalanche volunteered for this duty shortly after the meeting and will be the Field/Referee coordinator].

Bill Johnson will pick a date to train 'new' linesmen.

Other: 2002/2003 Tournament Schedule should be posted ~ April 15 on District 2 website.

Next Meeting: The next scheduled meeting is April 22, 2002, Cubberley Room A3. We do NOT plan to meet in May nor June. The July meeting is planned.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting was adjourned.
