**Fall Registration:** Mike Defrenza distributed fall registration packets and reviewed procedures that have changed from last fall. Team paperwork should be submitted directly to Alysia (the Redwood League registrar). Expect a 2 week turnaround. Birth certificates must be clearly readable, only one photo is used but submitting 2 is recommended, new player form this year does not require player signature. You may reuse the fall 2001 CYSA Player ID# if playing in Redwood League. Fee is \$30/player (rather than a team fee and separate player fees). Club number is '06', Region is '4B', State is '63', District is '02', League is '03'. Adult registration forms (also new this year) must be signed (especially because of liability concerns). May 1 is earliest date to submit registration and July 1 is 'drop dead' date. Teams also need to submit roster online (via Redwood League website).

**Coaching:** Juan Mayora is now certified to instruct the 'F' Coach Certification Class (required for fall 2002). He expects to hold 3 hour 'in class' session and a 6 hour 'on field' session. Every fall 2002 team must have a licensed coach ("F" certification or higher). Preliminary plan is to hold sessions, Monday June 3, 7-10PM and Saturday June 8, 8-2PM at JLS.

Juan and Jorge Espinoza will coach training sessions for Goalkeepers and Offensive players, Sundays, April 28 to June 9, 5:00 - 6:30PM, JLS Middle School. Cost is \$150. The plan is to train Goalkeepers and Offensive players separately for 45 minutes and then combine groups for 45 minutes for offense vs GK training. Assigning licensed referees to serve as linesmen for older teams games (e.g. U14 - U16) needs to be determined.

**Other:** 2002/2003 Tournament Schedule is posted on District 2 website; try to apply early.

Stanford University is sponsoring 8-12 year old player training, Mondays, 6-7:30PM, at Cubberley. Fee is \$80 for 4 sessions.

**Next Meeting:** The next scheduled meeting is July 22, 2002, Cubberley Room A3. We do NOT plan to meet in May nor June. The July meeting is focused on fall practice field assignments and attendance is mandatory.
