**Mandatory Coaches Meeting:** Bill Johnson issued a reminder that every team **must** have a certified coach attend a mandatory Abronzino League meeting on September 3 (for Class 1 teams) or Redwood League meeting September 4 (for Class 3 teams). **Linesman/Assistant Referee Training:** Bill Johnson will hold training on Thursday, September 5 from 6:15 to 7 p.m. at Greer 1 and is open to kids age 13 or older. Previously trained linespersons wanting a refresher are also welcome.

**Field Lining:** Chris Stirrat has completed lining Greer #1,2,5 Fields and will complete Greer #3,4 in the near future. The club is responsible to line all five Greer fields weekly throughout the fall season. Chris will assign 2 teams (from the club) per week to line the fields and distribute the list to the club teams.

**Treasurer:** Kevin Coleman has calculated the fall team fee is \$125/team payable to “Stanford Soccer Club”. Mail this to his address as shown in the club teams list.

**Field Space.** Fall practice field assignments are in effect after September 1. Three teams sharing one field should talk beforehand (ie. before the trainers arrive at the field) regarding how to use the field.

**Schedules/Referees:** Nancy Starr has emailed the draft for fall game field assignments. Nancy asked that each team confirm their scheduled games ASAP. Referees will then be assigned. The Tall Tree Tournament on September 28/29 will consume many local fields, including the Greer fields. Getting a home game field for those two days may be very difficult although Nancy is working on this.

To encourage the use of adult Assistant Referees for U13-U16 games, and encourage a larger pool of qualified referees a resolution was passed to change referee fees as follows:
