Field Space. Field permits handed out for practice and games. Chris Stirrat summarized the cramped practice fields problem as “too many kids, too few fields”. Some proposals (among others) at a Palo Alto Fields meeting were to add all weather field(s) with lights, and/or to convert property on El Camino and/or landfill. Expected field usage (between major maintenance) is 5-7 years and each field needs 4 million gallons of water (per year?!). It’s this water requirement that doomed JLS fields last summer after the water main break.

Schedules/Referees: There have been more than the ‘normal’ number of disputes this year involving parents, coaches and/or referees. The coaches and team must set an example for others and avoid escalating an issue.

Teams: Kevin Coleman intends to start new U11 team for the Fall 2003 season.
