Fields/Referees: After receiving input from all teams over the last week, Nancy Starr emailed the ‘final’ fall home game schedule to club contacts. This also is posted on club website. Avinesh has subsequently emailed referee contacts the schedule for their desired assignments. Nancy plans to include cell phone numbers of Avinesh, Bill Johnson, Chris Stirrat, Fausto and Juan Mayora who are licensed referees and may be contacted in case a “last minute” referee is needed (i.e., a referee does not show just before game time). In case of rain makeups during the season, contact Nancy to reschedule games.

The fall payment schedule of referees is:

Center and Assistant Referees must be licensed and wear badge. Unlicensed linesmen should not be used for older games.

Charlie Williams will email the weekly field lining assignments for the five Greer fields, effective September 1 through Dec 1. This will also be posted on club website.

After some discussion, it was agreed to leave nets up on the five fields for the duration of the fall season. The club will buy the nets from the Vortex, Storm, Landslide, Earthquakes, Blaze for \$100/each. Each of these teams should place the nets on a field and secure with plastic tie wraps (which discourages the removal of the nets).

Coaching: Mandatory Redwood League coaching meeting is to be held 7:30PM, Thursday, September 2 at the Belmont Sports Complex. Mandatory Abronzino League coaching meeting is to be held Tuesday, September 7 at Santa Clara University. Contact Redwood and Abronzino/District 2 websites for details.

Other: There is an opening for the club registrar position; contact Bill Johnson. The Firebolts are responsible for this duty if no other volunteer is identified. The position pays \$350/season.

Many of our club teams have also registered for US Club Soccer in addition to CYSA. US Club Soccer tournaments have proven to simplify application paperwork, especially for play outside of Northern California.

New volunteers: Tim Cain (Aftershocks) is the club Redwood League representative and Margie Cain (Wildfire) is the club Abronzino League representative. This is in lieu of other potential club positions.
